


What is the Instructor Development course?

The Instructor Development Course (IDC) is made up of two parts – the Assistant Instructor (AI) course and the Open Water Scuba Instructor (OWSI) program. Most dive professionals complete the entire IDC and go on to attend an Instructor Examination (IE), which is the final step to earn a PADI Instructor certification.

Prerequisites:

- A PADI Divermaster who has been a certified diver for six months may enroll in the PADI Instructor Development Course. You also need:
- At least 60 logged dives and 100 dives to attend an IE.
- Emergency First Response Primary and Secondary Care (CPR and First Aid) training within the past 24 months. You also need to be an Emergency First Response Instructor, but you can earn this rating during your instructor training.
- A medical statement signed by a physician within the last 12 months
- If you are a dive professional of another agency, consider crossover courses





What does a typical schedule look like?

Before we start:

- We really like to get to know you early, so before you even arrive, we schedule a skype call with you to discuss each other's expectations, questions etc.
- You complete your eLearning (IDC Online and ideally also the Dive Theory Online) at your own pace and convenience before you arrive and send your eRecords to us. To protect the environment, all our course documentation is completed online, no actual paper is wasted.

Days 1-10 of a typical eIDC:

- On day one and two, we will meet for the EFR-Instructor program as well as the O2 provider instructor course. Getting your first taste of teaching, you will brush up on your own EFR skills and then learn some teaching techniques so you can make your own future courses both educational and entertaining.
- Day 3 is the official start to the eIDC program with an orientation, in-water workshops of 24 skills and a fun team building event no pass/fail yet!
- ▶ Days 4 9 cover all requirements in 5 sections of the IDC
- Day 10 is reserved for individual counseling and practice ahead of the exams
- In between, there is time for additional support in forms of extra workshops, rescue practice, additional practice of the 24 skills, an extra Open Water Teaching presentation and the Project AWARE Specialty course "Dive Against Debris", which provides a welcomed "breather day" within the eIDC
- We also organize evening 'get togethers'/ social events to fully integrate our candidates in the Asia Divers family and ensure team dynamics

Days 11-12 are reserved for the Instructor Exams conducted by PADI:

- You will write 2 exams, hold a knowledge development (classroom) teaching presentation, teach in confined and open water as well as showcase rescue and some of your skills –all of which you have been prepared for during your IDC. A PADI examiner will evaluate you for a pass or fail in those segments.
- Usually the Instructor Exams conclude in the afternoon of the second day and its time for certificates and celebrations

- Many instructors choose to stay and complete further specialty instructor ratings to make themselves even more valuable to future employers.
- There are many specialties to choose from, such as for example:
 - ► Enriched Air Nitrox (EAN) often a pre-requisite in job postings
 - ▶ Deep, Wreck and Drift Diver are quite useful for an area such as Puerto Galera
 - ▶ DPV has gained a lot of popularity and is a very fun course to teach toys!
 - Sidemount, Gas Blender, Equipment Specialist and alike may give you a competitive edge
- Many opt for the 1 month instructor internship, teaching alongside our great instructor team to gain more experience and learn hands-on tips and tricks.
- Some people discover technical diving with one of the entry level PADI Tec Rec courses, e.g. Tec40 or if they already are 'teckies', proceed to the next level and become PADI Tec Deep Instructors



Equipment required (regardless where you do your IDC)

The required Diving equipment is listed in the PADI Instructor Manual under training standards, equipment. Please let us know if you are unable to bring all the required equipment and we can make sure it is available for rental here at Asia Divers.

Small stuff... In particular, please make sure you bring (or get it here):

- Pocket mask
- Timing device
- Compass
- Knife/diver's tool
- ▶ Two surface signaling devices one audible and one visible
- Calculator
- Pencil

Also please bring along for documentation purpose:

- Medical Examination Form signed by a physician (max. 12 months old)
- Verification of CPR and first aid training (max. 24 months old)
- Certification proof for OW, AOW, Rescue, EFR, DM or equivalent
- Diving logbook with minimum 100 dives signed off
- 2 passport size photographs

We will send you a link to a dropbox folder and we prefer you upload above documents there in advance to safe paper.



Lets talk about the facilities here at Asia Divers.

The dive shop is built out over the ocean on a raised platform which gives very easy access to the training area. You can just jump right on in and there is this beautiful Coral Reef, complete with all kinds of reef fish and the occasional turtle dropping by to say hello.



The swimming pool is located in El Galleon Beach Resort which is directly next to Asia Divers. Its not quite as exciting as the Ocean but has all the necessary components to teach a PADI SCUBA Course. Its relatively small size is testament to the small personalized classes we run at Asia Divers.

The classroom is very spacious. Made for functions up to 20 plus people, it easily handles the average class size of 4 to 6 IDC candidates. It's air-conditioned and has WiFi Access.

Diving in Puerto Galera

The Philippines is home to the most biologically diverse waters on Earth and the Verde Island Passage – the narrow body of water separating Luzon and Mindoro islands – is a biodiversity hotspot!



Besides the many critters, the sites here (30+ within about a 10 min boat ride) offer excellent drift dives, wall diving, most colorful reefs, muck diving, wrecks and deep sites ideal for technical training

What the scientists have to say about Puerto Galera's biodiversity!

- ▶ Just recently The California Academy of Sciences conducted an expedition in our area "The 2015 Verde Island Passage Marine Biodiversity Expedition: Puerto Galera. The expedition, the CAS said in a statement, affirms that the Philippines is the "center of the center" of marine biodiversity. The Philippines is jam-packed with diverse and threatened species it's one of the most astounding regions of biodiversity on Earth," says Terry Gosliner, PhD, senior curator of Invertebrate Zoology at the CAS and a Principal Investigator of the expedition.
